# Plastic Plumbers Strap Installation

## **Tools & Materials Needed:**

- Plastic plumber's strapping
- Screws or nails (appropriate for the mounting surface)
- Drill or screwdriver
- Tape measure
- Scissors or utility knife
- Pencil or marker
- Safety gloves



## Step-by-Step Installation:

### 1. Measure and Cut the Strapping

- Measure the length of strapping needed based on the pipe or fixture you are securing.
- Cut the strapping to the required length using scissors or a utility knife.
- Smooth any rough edges to prevent snags or damage to the pipe.

- Trim any excess strapping if necessary.
- o Inspect the installation for stability and make any needed adjustments.

# Safety Tips:

- ear safety gloves to prevent cuts while handling and installing.
- Use appropriate screws or nails depending on the mounting surface.
- Avoid overtightening to prevent damage to the pipe or strapping.
- Check the installation periodically to ensure continued security.



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
